Dear Mr. Denton:

The referenced letter requested an emergency Technical Specification amendment to Operating License DPR-25, Appendix A to extend the allowable repair period for a containment cooling subsystem. This letter is to inform you that we were able to complete the repairs on the 3A Low Pressure Coolant Injection Heat Exchanger within the seven day period specified in the existing Technical Specification. We therefore withdraw our request for the emergency amendment.

We acknowledge and appreciate the efforts of your staff in reviewing the information submitted. The Dresden Project Manager was notified by telephone of our intent to cancel the amendment request.
