Dear Mr. Denton:

The reference (a) Order required the Safety Parameter Display System (SPDS) be fully operational and operators trained by January 1, 1985. References (b) and (c) documented additional work remaining to complete the SPDS. Reference (c) provided an estimated completion date of August, 1985. As a result of problems experienced in procuring cable connectors (non-standard cable), detector calibration and due to the extensive nature of the required modifications, we've been unable to meet this schedule.

We currently project completion of the modifications, calibration and testing by early November 1985 providing there are no additional problems with equipment delivery or design. We will notify you of any change in this schedule. At this time, operator training on the SPDS has been completed.
