Dear Mr. Denton:

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.90, Commonwealth Edison Company proposes changes to Provisional Operating License DPR-19 and Operating License DPR-25 Appendix A, Technical Specifications. The proposed changes include the following:

1. Implement the coolant leak detection requirements of Generic Letter 84-11 Attachment 1, Section B for Dresden Unit 2 as requested in the referenced letter.
2. Revise the time period requirement for conducting the in-service inspection (ISI) program to reflect the second 10-year ISI period for Dresden Units 2 and 3.
3. Correct typographical errors for Dresden Unit 2.

The proposed amendments have been both On-Site and Off-Site reviewed. The revised Technical Specification pages and a summary of the changes is provided in Attachments 1 and 2 for Units 2 and 3, respectively.

We have reviewed this amendment request and find that no significant hazards consideration exists. Our review is documented in Attachment 3 which also reflects the technical basis for the changes. Commonwealth Edison will notify the State of Illinois of our request for this amendment and our appraisal on the question of no significant hazards by transmittal of a copy of this letter and its attachments to the designated State Official.

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In accordance with 10 CFR 170, a fee remittance in the amount of \$150.00 is enclosed.


