Dear Ms. Merck-Abeles

Your letter of June 10, 1980 requested copies of 1980 inspection report(s) of the Unit 1 containment building of the Seabrook Nuclear Power Station.

Our understanding is that your request pertains to inspection reports which include information regarding either the concrete structure of the containment building or the steel liner of the building. Two reports have been issued in 1980 which cover those areas, among other things. Inspection Report 50-443/80-01 covers cadweld splicing of Unit 1 containment building exterior walls and weld rod control for Unit 1 liner welding. Inspection Report 50-443/80-04 covers a potential significant deficiency reported by the licensee in the area of cadwelding in the containment building and other matters regarding containment building work by Perini. Copies of those inspection reports are enclosed.

These reports have previously been provided to the Local Public Document Room (LPDR) for the convenience of interested persons such as yourself. In accordance with our normal policy, all future Inspection and Enforcement inspection reports will also be provided to the LPDR, the location of which is as follows:
