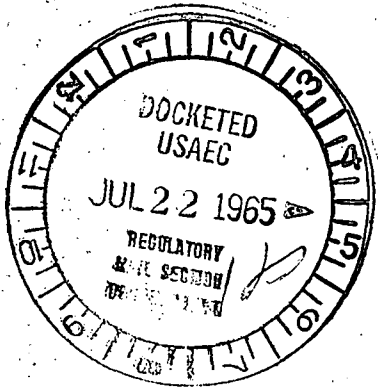

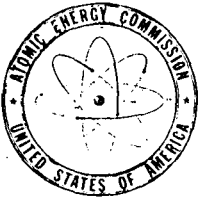

AMENDMENT TO INDEMNITY AGREEMENT NO. B-10

AMENDMENT NO. 4

Effective at 12:01 A.M., July 1, 1965, Indemnity Agreement No. B-10 between Commonwealth Edison Company and the Atomic Energy Commission dated December 14, 1961, as amended, is hereby further amended by deleting Item 4 of the Attachment to the indemnity agreement in its entirety and substituting the following therefor:

Item 4 - Location

That part of Section Twenty-five (25) lying Southerly of the Illinois River and Westerly of the Kankakee River; also, that part of the South Eight Hundred (800) feet of the East Five Hundred (500) feet of Section Twenty-six (26); also, that part of the North Five Hundred (500) feet of the East Five Hundred (500) feet of Section Thirty-five (35); also that part of the North Five Hundred (500) feet of Section Thirty-six (36) lying Westerly of the Kankakee River; all in Township Thirty-four (34) North, Range Eight (8) East of the Third Principal Meridian, Grundy County, Illinois, occupied by Commonwealth Edison Company's Dresden Nuclear Power Station and enclosed by plant security fence, as indicated on plat dated May 13, 1965, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and made a part hereof.

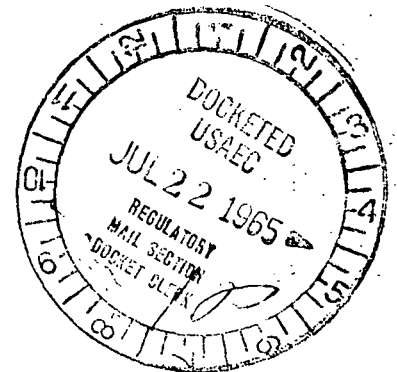
