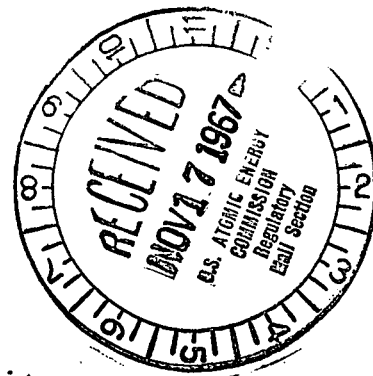

Safety Analysis Report for Dresden Units
 2 and 3 - AEC Dkts 50-237 and 50-249

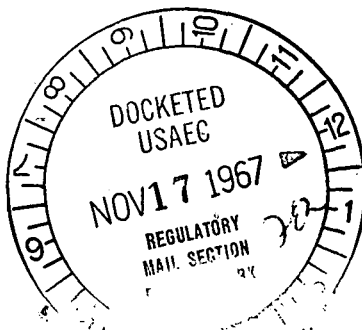
Dear Dr. Morris:

Regulatory Formal File Cy,

The applications for construction permits and operating licenses for Dresden Unit 2, filed April 15, 1965, in AEC Dkt 50-237, and for Dresden Unit 3, filed February 10, 1966, in AEC Dkt 50-249, are hereby amended by submission of the Safety Analysis Report for Dresden Units 2 and 3 pursuant to Sec. 50.34 of 10CFR50. As stated in the Amendment dated March 30, 1966 to the application respecting Dresden Unit 2, Units 2 and 3 are virtually identical in design and accordingly a single Safety Analysis Report is submitted for both units.

Consistent with the proposed amendment of Sec. 50.34 of 10CFR50 published February 14, 1967 (32F.R.2851) the Safety Analysis Report analyzes the design of each unit for operation at the ultimate power level currently contemplated, 2527 Mwt or the equivalent net electrical output of 809 MW. Accordingly, it is requested that the design of Units 2 and 3 be reviewed for operation at power levels up to 2527 Mwt and that facility licenses be issued authorizing operation of each of such units at such power level subject to the conduct of such tests and demonstrations and the submission of such further reports as the Commission may deem appropriate. It is further requested that the construction permits for Units 2 and 3, CPPR-18 and CPPR-22, respectively, be amended accordingly.

It is planned to file as promptly as possible additions to the Safety Analysis Report relating to the meteorology and site limits for Dresden Nuclear Power Station, a design evaluation in respect of

the proposed AEC General Design Criteria, the fabrication of the reactor pressure vessel and the primary containment and proposed technical specifications.

A copy of this letter and the Safety Analysis Report for Dresden Units 2 and 3 will be served on the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors of Grundy County prior to December 1, 1967.
