Dear Dr. Morris:

Responsive to your letter of May 24 and to confirm your telephone conversation with John H. Hughes, Commonwealth Edison Company has reviewed with General Electric Company the preparation of the report on the Emergency Core Cooling System which you requested.


We had already begun preparation of the final Safety Analysis Report for Dresden Station Units 2 and 3. This will include as part of the Engineered Safeguards Section the detailed description of the final design of the E.C.C.S. We had planned to file the Safety Analysis Report (SAR) about November 1. The earliest date on which we could submit a special report on the E.C.C.S. is October 1. This would delay the filing of the SAR to about December 1.

The Engineered Safeguards Section of the SAR will include all of the information requested in your May 24 letter. Additionally, it will deal with such matters in terms of the final E.C.C.S. design and incorporate in such design any changes that may result from further research and development.

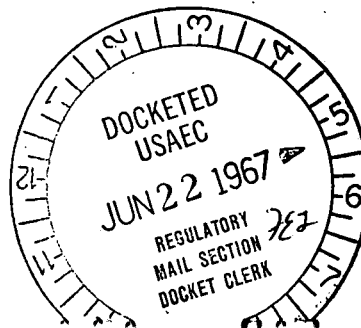
Since we are unable to advance significantly the date such E.C.C.S. report could be submitted separately, we propose to file the final SAR on or about November 1. I understand that this arrangement is agreeable with you.
