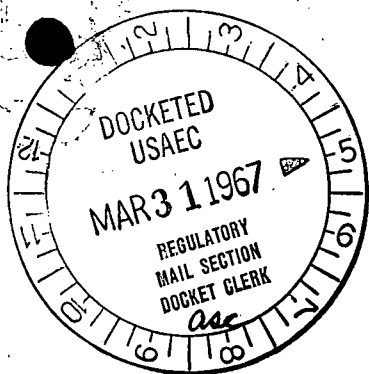
Dear Mr. Boyd:

In response to your letter requests, each dated January 31, 1967 we have attached the following:

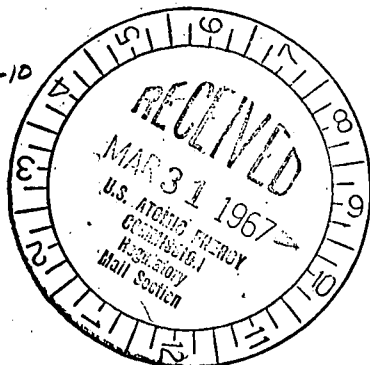

Dear Norm:

At your request, we have developed an estimate, in accordance with a request you received from the USAEC by letter R. Boyd dated January 31, 1967, for withdrawals of special nuclear material in 1968, 1969. This estimate is categorized as "probable". It does not include returns as these are small and already estimated on an annual basis in the CP application. At the request of the USAEC, this information was telephoned to Mr. Nick Doulous (973.7409) in Bethesda on 2/28/67 by the writer because the internal AEC report was due and the information was already late. Mr. Doulous indicated the report was entirely satisfactory for his purpose, but did request written confirmation from Commonwealth Edison Company.
