Dear Mr. Denton:

This letter is provided at the request of the Dresden Project Manager to document our conformance to 10 CFR 50.49 requirements for Dresden Unit 2. At this time, all Dresden Unit 2 equipment identified to be within the scope of 10 CFR 50.49 as described in our previous submittals has been qualified. As documented in references (a) and (b), this certification does not apply to Regulatory Guide 1.97 equipment which is being qualified in accordance with the reference (c) Confirmatory Order on NUREG-0737 Supplement 1 implementation.

As part of our equipment qualification program, we have instituted an ongoing surveillance and maintenance program. This program will assure the continued qualification of applicable equipment through periodic maintenance and inspection. Any equipment deficiencies or accelerated degradation identified through this program will be resolved in accordance with the guidance provided in Generic Letter 85-15.
