Dear Mr. Davis:

The purpose of this letter is to explore the viability of electronic transfer of US NRC Inspection Reports to Commonwealth Edison to supplement the present system of distribution via US Mail. It would be used for the six Commonwealth Edison Stations.

Presently, Inspection Reports are delivered by US Mail and may require 1 to 2 weeks to reach the individual who will be responsible to draft the response. With electronic transfer, Inspection Reports could be transmitted to Nuclear Licensing the same day that the NRC signs the reports. The reports could then be transferred from Licensing to the individual at each Station having responsibility to prepare the response. This enhancement could improve the quality of response as well as the timeliness of response.

I would like to establish a meeting of the appropriate technical personnel to establish the methodology and controls necessary to properly control and evaluate this communication process. Possibly a trial period could be established at the end of which an evaluation of the effectiveness and cost could be made.
