This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by S. G. DuPont and P. D. Kaufman of this office on March 18 through May 9, 1988, of activities at Dresden Nuclear Power Station, Units 2 and 3 authorized by NRC Operating License No. DPR-19 and No. DPR-25 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. E. Eenigenburg and others at the conclusion of the inspection.
