Mr. McKenna,

I have attached the meeting notice and agenda for the PEC on July 31. Please note in the agenda that you will have the opportunity to make opening remarks and to provide your perspective on the apparent violations and any other information that you believe the NRC should take into consideration before making an enforcement decision. As stated in the letter dated June 5, 2017, NRC has not made a decision that violations occurred or that an enforcement action will be taken. The topics discussed during the conference may include information to determine whether a violation occurred, information to determine the significance of a violation, information related to the identification of a violation and information related to any corrective actions taken or planned. You should be aware that the promptness and comprehensiveness of your actions will be considered in assessing any civil penalty for the apparent violations.
