Dear Mr. Murley:

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.59 and 10 CFR 50.90, Commonwealth Edison proposes to amend Appendix A, Technical Specifications to Provisional Operating License DPR-19 and Facility Operating License DPR-25 for Dresden Units 2 and 3 respectively, to reflect instrumentation enhancements for post-accident monitoring completed per Regulatory Guide 1.97 and NUREG-0737 Supplement 1. The proposed changes are contained in Attachment 1 and are further described in Attachment 2.

In addition to updating information such as the panel locations for some relocated or added instruments and slightly modified instrument ranges, several minor corrections and clarifications have been incorporated. The Dresden Station instrument calibration procedures will reflect the affected instrument ranges and will be used to assure consistent calibrations in the interim until the affected Technical Specification tables have been updated.

The proposed changes have been reviewed and approved by both On-Site Review and Off-Site Review in accordance with the requirements of the Technical Specifications. We have also reviewed them in accordance with 10 CFR 50.92(c). This evaluation, which is documented in Attachment 3, concluded that no significant hazards considerations are created by this amendment.


Commonwealth Edison is notifying the State of Illinois of this application by copy of this letter to the designated State Official. In accordance with 10 CFR 170, a fee remittance in the amount of \$150.00 is also enclosed.


