Dear Mr. Murley:

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.90, Commonwealth Edison proposes to amend Appendix A, Technical Specifications to Provisional Operating Licenses DPR-19 and Facility Operating License DPR-25 for Dresden Nuclear Power Station. The proposed amendment revises the Unit 2 and 3 Technical Specifications as part of the Dresden Station Improvement Program's Technical Specification Action Plan. The proposed changes revise the testing requirements for other systems or subsystems of Emergency Core Cooling System (ECCS) or Standby Gas Treatment Systems (SBGT) when one system or subsystem is inoperable. These changes are consistent with similar specifications approved for later BWRs and the BWR Standard Technical Specifications. The changes are contained in Attachment 1 and further described in Attachments 2 and 3.

The proposed changes have been reviewed and approved by both On-Site and Off-Site Review in accordance with Commonwealth Edison Company procedures. We have reviewed these proposed amendments in accordance with 10 CFR 50.92(c) and determined that no significant hazards consideration exists. This evaluation is documented in Attachment 4.

Commonwealth Edison is notifying the State of Illinois of our application for this amendment by transmitting a copy of this letter and its attachment to the designated State Official.

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In accordance with 10 CFR 170, a fee remittance in the amount of \$150.00 is also enclosed.

Review and approval of this amendment is requested by January, 1989. Please direct any questions you may have regarding this matter to this office.


