Good afternoon Dr. Cassata,

Mr. Simpson indicated in a previous letter to the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that the decommissioning and decontamination of the CDC Lawrenceville Facility had been completed and approved by the NRC. However, we have been unable to locate at our onsite facility the documentation for the decommissioning of the CDC Lawrenceville Facility located at 602 Webb Gin House Road, Lawrenceville, GA 30245. We believe this documentation is archived at the National Archives Center due to a recent initiative to archive many of our hardcopy documents.

Please see the attached memorandum which Paul Simpson sent to the NRC on August 4, 2014. In this letter Mr. Simpson explains that the CDC Lawrenceville Facility, which was listed on the CDC Materials License (#10-06772-01) had been decontaminated and decommissioned. Mr. Simpson also points out that the NRC had approved that decommissioning of this facility. He further explains that due to CDC's mission, the CDC plans to retain the Lawrenceville Research Facility on the CDC Materials License (#10-06772-01).

We request that the NRC accept this as verification that the CDC Lawrenceville Facility has been decontaminated and decommissioned.
