Dr. Murley:

Commonwealth Edison transmitted the response to the NRC Generic Letter 88-11 in the referenced letter. In the response, Commonwealth Edison committed to submit revised curves, calculated in accordance with the February 1986 draft revision of Regulatory Guide 1.99, Revision 2, by March 31, 1989. During the preparation of the submittal for NRC review, several technical issues surfaced which were not identified during the initial review of the pressure-temperature curves. Commonwealth Edison is aggressively pursuing resolution of these technical issues and has verified that the curves are conservative.

Commonwealth Edison is currently developing new pressure-temperature curves in accordance with the guidance contained in Regulatory Guide 1.99, Revision 2 (May, 1988). These curves will be submitted to the NRC by September 30, 1989. The revision to the initial commitment dates were discussed via teleconference with the Dresden and Quad Cities Project Managers on April 5, 1989, and April 26, 1989, respectively.
