Dr. Murley:

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 50.90, Commonwealth Edison Company (CECo) proposes to amend Provisional Operating License No. DPR-19 and Facility Operating License No. DPR-25, Appendix A, Technical Specifications to improve and standardize the Instrumentation Tables and related requirements. This amendment is part of the Dresden Station Improvement Program's Technical Specification Action Plan which was initiated in 1988.

Attachment 1 provides a detailed discussion of the proposed Technical Specification changes. A list which summarizes each of the proposed changes is provided in Attachment 2. The proposed Technical Specification page changes are provided in Attachment 3. Attachment 4 documents the CECo determination of No Significant Hazards Consideration (NSHC) based on the criteria in 10 CFR 50.92. The proposed amendment has been reviewed and approved by CECo On-Site and Off-Site Review in accordance with Company procedures.

CECo is notifying the State of Illinois of our request and our determination of NSHC by providing a copy of this letter and the attachments to the Illinois Department of Nuclear Safety.


