Dr. Murley:

The referenced letter requested that licensees provide the implementation status of a number of generic safety issues (GSI's) by June 29, 1990. While this schedule is attainable for the four Commonwealth Edison (CECo) units at Braidwood and LaSalle, additional time will be needed to research and verify the requested information for the eight units at Dresden, Quad Cities, Zion and Byron Station.

CECo expects that the requested information can be compiled for Byron Station's units in less than two weeks and the older units of Dresden, Quad Cities and Zion Stations by approximately July 31, 1990. CECo appreciates the benefits of obtaining Staff agreement on the implementation status for these items and the establishment of a single, common reference document which will result from this effort.
