Dear Mr. Ryals:

This letter refers to the inspection conducted on May 1, 2017, at your Hickory, Pennsylvania facility and on May 2, 2017, at a temporary job site in West Union, West Virginia and continued in office review through June 27, 2017. This inspection examined activities conducted under your license as they relate to public health and safety, and to confirm compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selected examination of procedures and representative records, observations of activities, and interviews with personnel.

Based on the results of this inspection, the NRC has determined that two Severity Level IV (SL IV) violations of NRC requirements occurred. The violations were evaluated in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy. The current Enforcement Policy is included on the NRC's Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/enforcement/>. The violations are cited in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice) because they were identified by the NRC. Additionally, in the Notice, the violations are grouped together as a single SL IV problem. This is in recognition that both violations resulted from the same root cause and do not represent separate regulatory breakdowns.

The NRC has concluded that information regarding: (1) the reason for the violations; (2) the corrective actions that have been taken and the results achieved; and (3) the date when full compliance was achieved is already adequately addressed on the docket. Therefore, you are not required to respond to this letter unless the description herein does not accurately reflect your corrective actions or your position. In that case, or if you choose to provide additional information, you should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice.

However, the material enclosed herewith contains Security-Related Information in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390(d)(1) and its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.
