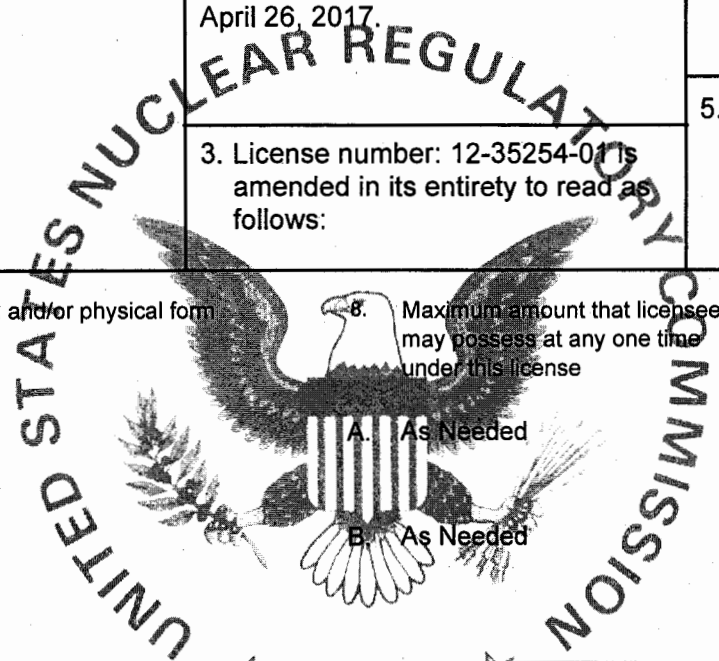


**MATERIALS LICENSE**

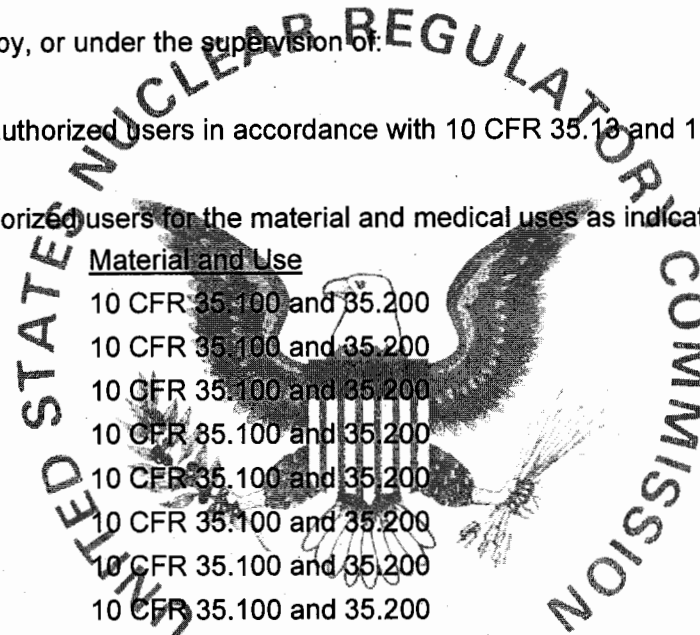

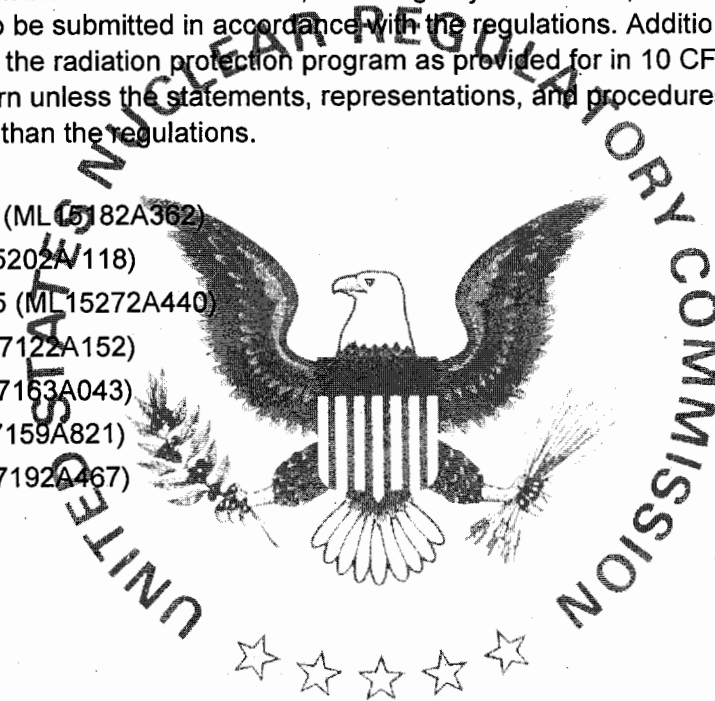
