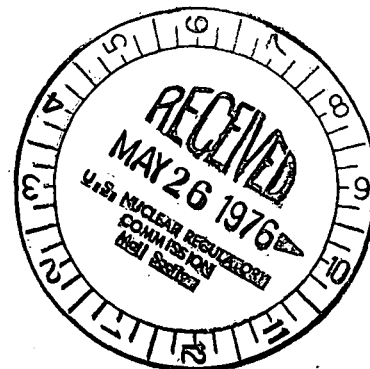

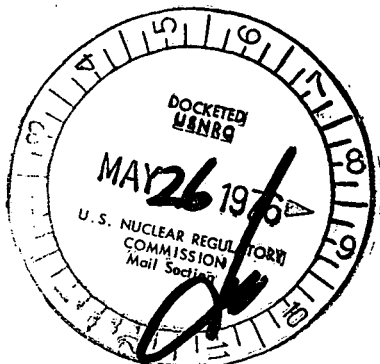
Dear Mr. Rusche:

After conversations with your staff, Commonwealth Edison Company agrees to (1) evaluate the impact on plant safety of the removal of the automated transfer scheme on Buses 28-7/29-7, and (2) propose and implement a design change on the single bus that meets the requirements of IEEE Standard 308-1971 and the recommendations of Regulatory Guide 1.6 or transmit additional justification for the present design.

Future proposals for the system require that Commonwealth Edison Company be furnished an official statement of your specific concerns for the present arrangement.
