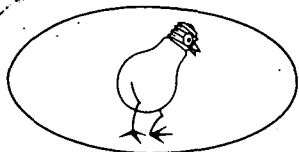

We have reviewed our May, 1969 licensing exam requirements as stated in our letter to you of January 7, 1969, and find our oral exam requirements for Dresden Unit 2 is still 35 Dresden people (18 SRO and

17 RO) plus the six General Electric Startup Engineers who will be taking written and demonstration exams the week of March 24. Of the 35 Dresden operators, four are currently in the BWR Simulator training and will also require the RO written and demonstration. One of the 35 Dresden Operators (V. Danese) will be ready to repeat his RO written with the May group.

There is one holdover from the January 21 - 24, 1969, group of Unit 1 exams, i.e., K. J. Wiers who has the demonstration and walkthru to complete. We would like to complete this exam during a plant shutdown tentatively scheduled in the last half of April.

This is a full program and defines more clearly the total licensing needs. Please call if you have any comments or questions.

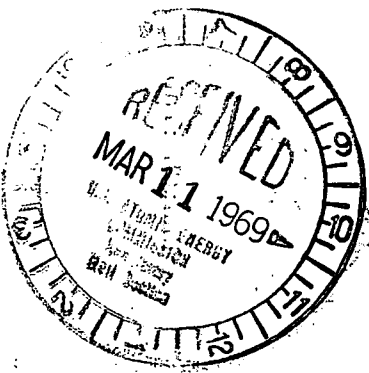

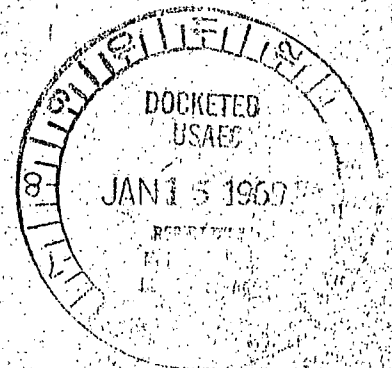

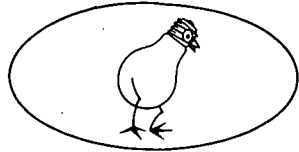

Dear Mr. Kelly:

The following suggested examination dates for Dresden Nuclear Power Station people are submitted for your study and planning, these examination sequences follow our telephone conversation of December 30, 1968, and are acceptable at the G.E. Simulator.

Our Next group of examinations for six Reactor Operators and four Senior Reactor Operators has been scheduled for the week of January 20, 1969. These examinations are the written and demonstration.

We request that written and demonstration examinations be given to four Senior Reactor Operators and one Reactor Operator during the week of March 24, 1969. These people will complete Simulator School on March 14, 1969.

Along with the Edison personnel available to take a March exam, there will be six General Electric startup engineers who will request examination. *Part GE people all SRO*

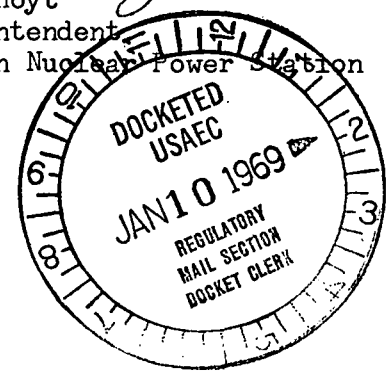
Our next sequence of exams will include three Reactor Operators and one Senior Reactor Operator written and demonstration exams and plant walk throughs for about 35 Dresden People. We request the last two weeks in May for these examinations, (5-19-69 - 5-29-69).

Make-up exams for the two Senior Reactor Operators and one Reactor Operator failures may be scheduled for the March 24, 1969 sequence, if not, they will be added to the May sequence.

These are our plans for licensing, please call if you have any questions.
