Supplementary Information

Based on our initial interpretation of Item 2.B of IE Bulletin 79-10, we supplied information about the number of operators who were required to attend requalification lectures subsequent to annual requalification examinations. At the time of our initial response, successfully passing the reexamination following a lecture series was considered equivalent to having actually attended the lectures.

During IE Inspection 79-15, Mr. W. A. Ruhlman of your staff informed us that Bulletin 79-10 requires information about the number of operators who actually attended a lecture series. Based on Mr. Ruhlman's explanation, we have supplemented our response to the Bulletin by adding Note 4 (actual attendance at lectures).

The practice of "attendance by examination" has been discontinued at St. Lucie. Physical attendance is now required at requalification lectures dealing with any subject on which an individual licensed operator received less than 80% on an annual requalification examination.
