SUBJECT: BOMB THREAT

At 3:12 p.m. on February 13, 1980, an unknown individual telephoned the Unit 2 switchboard and told the receptionist: "There will be a bomb going off within the hour". The licensee is conducting a search of Unit 2. The Unit 2 site was not evacuated. The licensee notified the St. Lucie Sheriff's Department. Unit 2 construction is 20% complete and no fuel is on site. Unit 1 is operating at power. The licensee increased surveillance on the Unit I site and surveyed the interface barrier between the units with caplusive detection dogs. The results were negative.

Hedia interest is not expected and a press release is not planned by the licensee or the NRC. The State of Florida was notified.

The IAT was notified.

Region II (Atlanta) received notification of this occurrence by telephone from the licensee at 3:50 p.m. on February 13, 1980.
