NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Florida Power and Light Company St. Lucie Facility

License No. CPPR-144

Based on the NRC inspection January 8-11, 1980, certain of your activities were apparently not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements as indicated below. These items have been categorized as described in correspondence to you dated December 31, 1974.

As required by Criterion V of Appendix B, 10 CFR 50, implemented by Florida Power and Light Topical Quality Assurance Report 5.0, "Activities affecting quality shall be prescribed by documented instructions, procedures or drawings ... and shall be accomplished in accordance with these instructions, procedures or drawings." Florida Power and Light (FP&L) Procedure QWP-19, "Site Quality Procedure Indoctrination and Training," requires that manual employees receive an indoctrination program to familiarize new employees with the principals, policies, and procedures unique and committed to nuclear regulatory requirements and the manner in which they are accomplished by use of written controls for construction. QWP-19 requires that records be maintained which document the conduct of training and indoctrination activities.

Contrary to the above, an indoctrination program is not administered to manual employees and indoctrination records are not maintained for manual employees.

This is a deficiency.
