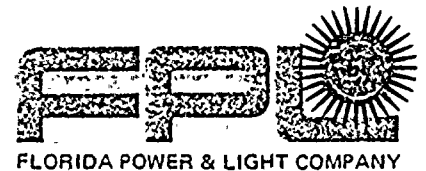



In response to your letter of April 10, 1980, Florida Power & Light Company has prepared changes to the St. Lucie Unit 1 and Turkey Point Units 3 & 4 Technical Specifications. The proposed changes require review by the plant nuclear review committees and the Company Nuclear Review Board prior to submittal to the NRC. We plan to complete the appropriate reviews and submit the proposed changes by June 15, 1980.
