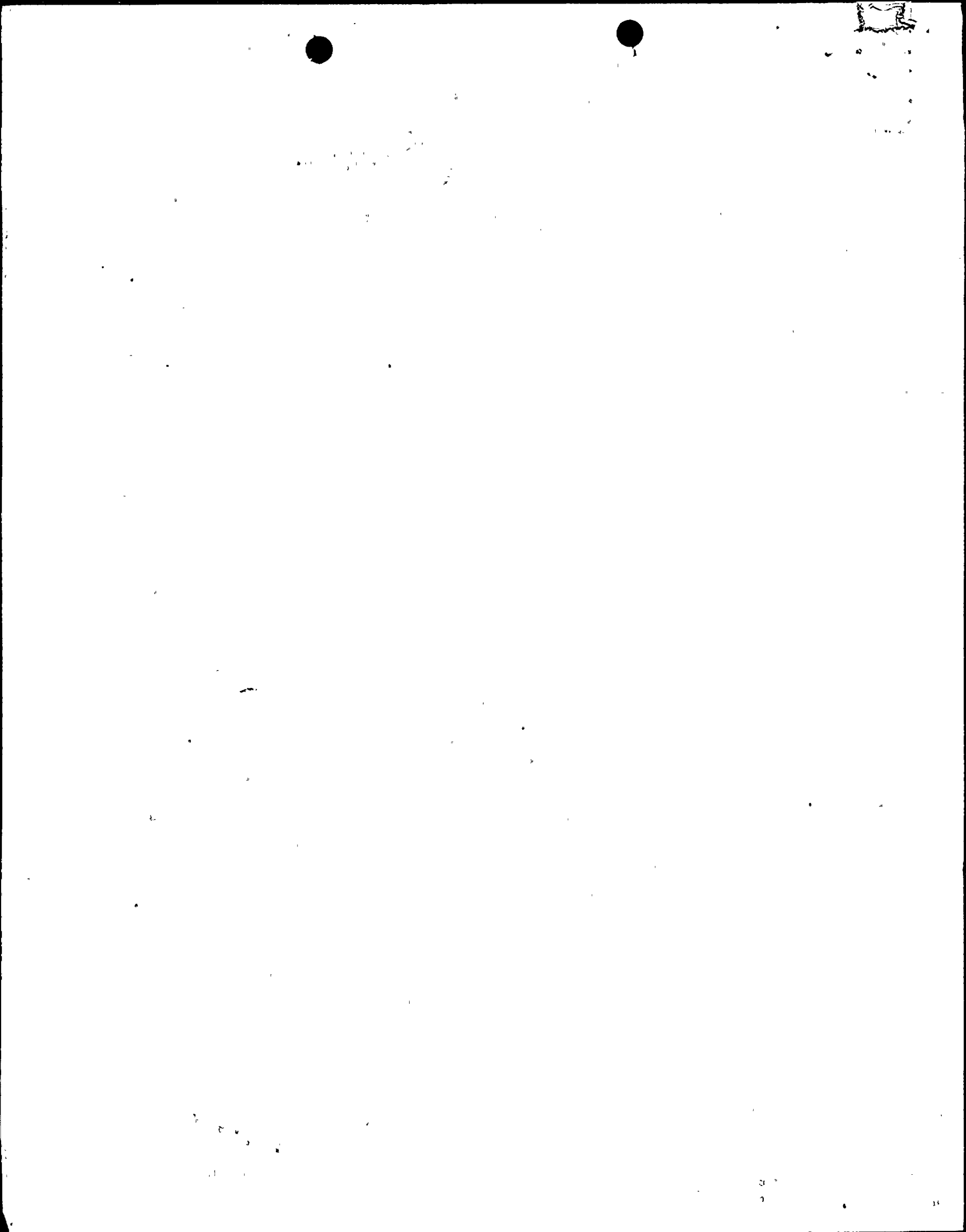

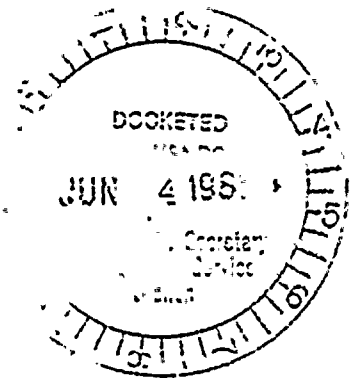

- Page 1 - Aerial view of RRD's resource recovery plant showing six cooling towers (mid-foreground), two stacks and four electrostatic precipitators (left). Four boilers and two turbogenerators are in the central structures, with the step-up transformers and switchyard to their right. The 240 kv intertie line runs from the switchyard, west (leftwards) between the cooling towers and stacks, then north to the street, then east (rightwards) to FP&L's north-south Turkey Point line (off picture, to right). Across the street (background) is the non-conforming 58th Street landfill due to be replaced by the resource recovery plant.
- Page 2 - The resource recovery plant's 240 kv intertie line (left) stands ready to interconnect with FP&L's 240 kv Turkey Point line (right).
