Your letter of July 16, 1981, to the Director of our Division of Licensing has been forwarded to me for reply. You requested copies of the proposed operating license and the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safetuards (ACRS) report for the St. Lucie Plant, Unit No. 2. The review of the application by Florida Power and Light Company for an operating license for the St. Lucie Plant, Unit No. 2, has not progressed to the point of issuance of either of these items. Although the staff is conducting its review of St. Lucie 2, we have not yet made a determination regarding issuance of an operating license nor have we prepared a proposed license.

As a matter of routine, the ACRS report is issued following a meeting by the ACRS to discuss an application for a construction permit or an operating license. The ACRS meeting for St. Lucie 2 is tentatively scheduled for November. We will send you a copy of the ACRS report when it becomes available.

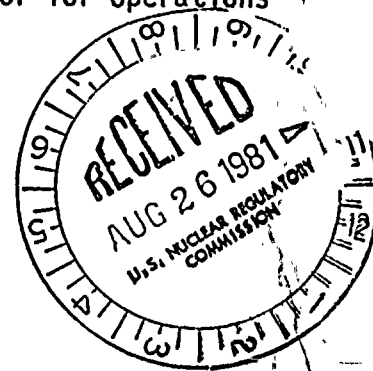
