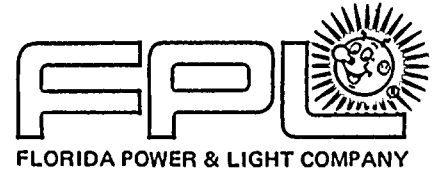

By letters dated July 1 and September 16, 1977, Florida Power & Light submitted a proposed inservice inspection program for St. Lucie Unit 1. This proposal, received interim NRC approval, with some additional restrictions, in December 20, 1977.

The period for the proposed program, which has been in use since that time, has expired. We have reviewed our proposed program, and have determined that it is still applicable. We will therefore continue to use this previously submitted program, subject to the restrictions in the December 20, 1977 NRC letter, for the present inspection period. This period started February 1, 1981 and ends February 1, 1991.
