3.0 Scope:

JHB 7-29-81

3.1 Purpose

This procedure describes the members and duties of the On-Site Emergency Organization (see Figure 1).

3.2 Discussion

During the period immediately following the declaration of an emergency, the shift operating staff constitutes the immediate response organization, i.e., the Interim Emergency Teams. Emergency requirements take immediate precedence over normal operating responsibilities (as determined by Emergency Procedures or at the direction of the Emergency Coordinator). Subsequent to the immediate response actions and notifications, off-duty plant staff will begin arriving to form the Primary Emergency Teams and to staff the Technical Support Center. The On-Site Emergency Organization reports to and supports the Emergency Coordinator.

3.3 Authority

This procedure implements the St. Lucie Plant Radiological Emergency Plan.

3.4 Definitions

3.4.1 Emergency Coordinator

Responsible for notifying off-site authorities, both inside and outside the Company and has full authority and responsibility for on-site emergency response actions. This function is performed by the Nuclear Plant Supervisor. His normal alternate is the Watch Engineer. The Operations
