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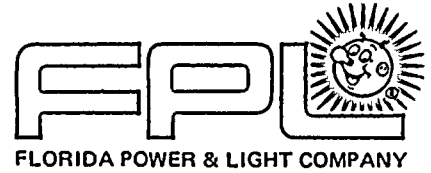
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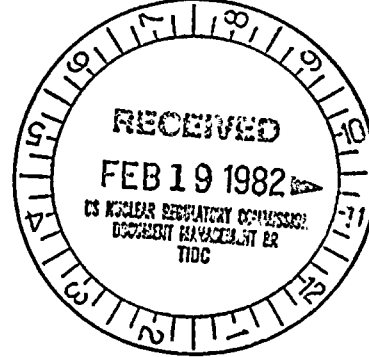

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.90, Florida Power & Light Company submits herewith three signed originals and forty copies of a request to amend Appendix A of Facility Operating License DPR-67.

This amendment is submitted to remove the description of FPL's offsite management and technical support from Section 6.2 of the Technical Specification. In addition, the listing of the specific members of the Company Nuclear Review Board (CNRB) has been removed from the Technical Specifications. These changes are proposed to minimize information duplication and reduce the necessity for License Amendments caused by future organizational changes and individual title changes.

Pages 6-1 and 6-2

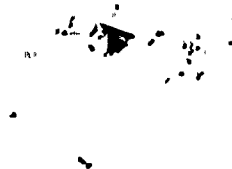


