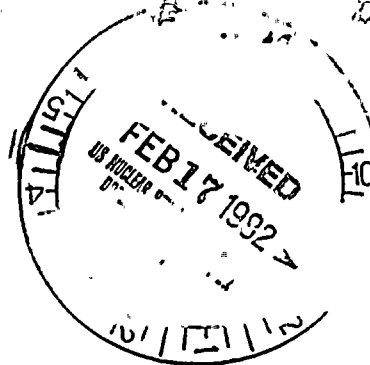

The fourth step is the creation of a common social system, which is achieved through the establishment of a common education system, a common health system, and a common social security system. The fifth step is the creation of a common international system, which is achieved through the establishment of a common foreign policy, a common diplomatic system, and a common international law system.
