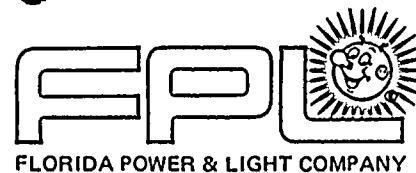

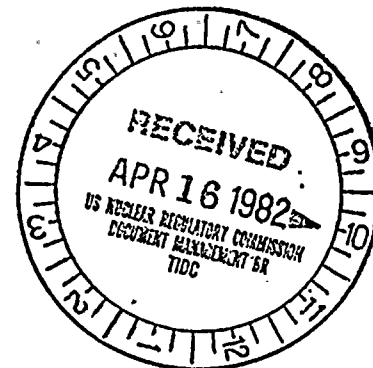

Florida Power & Light has reviewed your letter dated March 25, 1982 concerning our ability to control St. Lucie Unit 1 through a postulated loss of all AC power event. We are planning to provide a response to your analytical concerns by May 13, 1982.

Although we have prepared a draft procedure based on our previous work on this subject, we will not be able to complete the procedure until our response to the analytical portion of your request has been finalized. Our procedure, therefore, is scheduled to be issued by July 6, 1982.

Because our training program will be based on the procedure, the training program modifications will take additional time to complete. We now plan to have the training program in place by August 4, 1982. We will provide a detailed description of our procedure and our training program by August 4, 1982.
