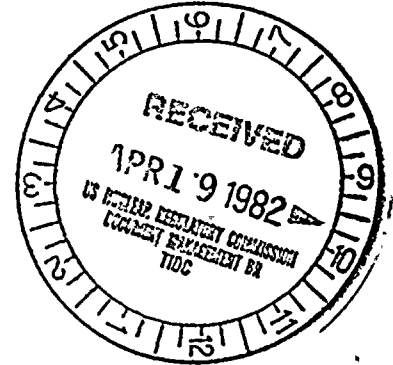

Refr: RTD Response Time Determination at St. Lucie Unit No. 1

Dear Dr. Uhrig:

By letter dated August 28, 1981, we provided a Safety Evaluation (SE) on two different Loop Current Step Response (LCSR) methods for determining the RTD response time and requested that you make application for certain TS changes within 120 days from receipt of that letter. Since issuance of that letter, the SE has been released as NUREG-0809. A copy of this NUREG is enclosed for your review and use.

NUREG-0809 is provided as an early notification of a possibly significant matter. Contrary to the wording of the NUREG positions (Page 29 to 31) and our August 28, 1981 letter, it is not being implemented as a requirement at this time. It is expected that you will review the information for possible applicability to your facility. No specific action or response to this letter is requested. If NRC evaluations so indicate, further licensee actions may be required. We will consider your March 24, 1982 letter on this subject in any further evaluations. If you have questions regarding this subject, please contact your assigned NRC project manager.
