

o Facilities

Mr. Miller conducted a tour of the C-E EVP Task Force facilities, which consist of three inter-connected office trailers located approximately 1/4 mile from the building housing the C-E St. Lucie Project team.

o Verification Item Boundaries

Verification item boundaries as established by the C-E and Ebasco Task Forces will be documented via letters to Mr. Christian.

o Design Inputs

Status of responses to the initially requested design inputs was discussed along with overall program progress. Mr. Miller advised that inputs for C-E verification items have not yet been received by the C-E Task Force. Mr. Christian reiterated that requested inputs may be transmitted directly to the Task Force from the Project team, with formal written confirmation to follow through him. Mr. Blodgett noted that an additional information request is being prepared by the Ebasco Task Force.

o Procedures

Revision 1 to overall program procedure EVP-001/SL-2, which was previously prepared, will be distributed on August 13. Task Force EVP administrative and technical procedures will remain as internal documents.

o Upcoming Meetings

The next meeting of the Task Force managers was tentatively scheduled for August 26, in Juno Beach.
