Subsequent to the issuance of the Safety Evaluation Report (SER) for St. Lucie Unit 2, NUREG 0843 and its supplement, an attempt to clarify section 3.11 was made by FP&L.

Dr. Rosztochy, Chief Equipment Qualification Branch, Division of Engineering indicated in his memorandum to F. Miraglia, attached, that this clarification of Category I/Category II of NUREG 0588 pertaining to St. Lucie #2 was not acceptable. He stated that St. Lucie Unit 2 adhere to Category I requirements as advised in the Commission Memorandum and Order (CLI-80-21) and NUREG 0588. We are in agreement with this position and so state in the St. Lucie Unit #2 Environmental Qualification Report & Guidebook, Volume I, paragraph 6.

The Guidebook officially submitted by References 1, 2 & 3 and reviewed by your staff, if directly referenced in the SER would remove the ambiguities of this issue.
