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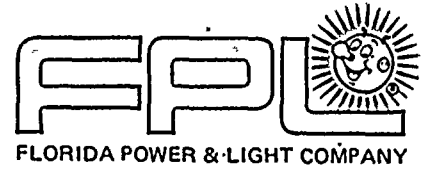

As discussed in a meeting with your staff on September 10, 1982, Florida Power & Light Co. is revising its commitment concerning St. Lucie Unit 2 operator licensing as described in Section 13.2 of the Final Safety Analysis Report. These changes are described below:

Section 13.2.1.1.1

Additional personnel will be employed to supplement the cadre of previously licensed operators on St. Lucie Unit 1 that are to be licensed on St. Lucie Unit 2. This will be needed to ensure adequate staffing levels and optimal use of staff experience to operate both Unit 1 and Unit 2. These additional personnel will have previous licensed operator or equivalent experience.

Section 13.2.1.1.1 a) & b)

The training program for personnel who will initially license on St. Lucie Unit 2 will be modified. Prior experience credit is described in Section 13.2.1.1.1 b). In addition, training similar to that described in 13.2.1.1.1 a) will be provided. However, this training will only address St. Lucie Unit 2.
