7/06/17	<p>On Thursday evening, July 6, 2017, the Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO) will update all NRC workstations (headquarters and regions) with the June Microsoft Security Patches and Google Chrome 59.0.3071.109. This update will take approximately 20-30 minutes and will require one reboot upon completion.</p> <p>Details on the updates can be found on the NRC Customer Service Catalog Monthly Security Updates section near the bottom of the page.</p> <p>Impact for standard desktop users: OCIO will schedule automatic deployments after 7:00 p.m., local time. When you leave for the day, please save your work and close all applications to avoid the possibility of losing any unsaved work. Log off your computer, but leave it powered on. There is a reboot after the patches are installed.</p> <p>Impact for mobile desktop (laptop) users: Please read carefully if you are using VPN full time or will not be in the office during the install period.</p> <p>Laptops that are on campus - If your laptop is connected to the NRC network at HQ or any of the regions during the night, you can leave it powered on and logged off and the updates will be run during the night. This will only work if the laptop is in its docking station or directly connected to the network. VPN users must use a different method. Do not Restart or Shutdown.</p> <p>VPN Users - If you will not be in the office, you can run the update during the day by using Software Center to install the patches. Details on how to use Software Center will be sent to you in a separate e-mail. If you are a laptop user and do not receive the 'How To' e-mail by July 6, contact John Davis, 301-287-0795.</p> <p>Laptops that have not been upgraded manually by COB July 14, 2017, will have the updates automatically executed on the next login.</p>
