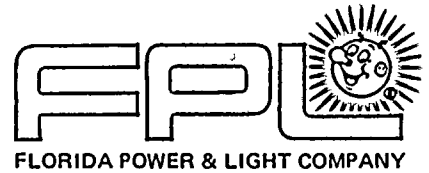

Your letter dated September 28, 1983 transmitted your approval of ten of the eleven criteria applicable to the Post-Accident Sampling System. You noted that a schedule for the eleventh criterion (Core Damage Assessment Procedure) should be developed and submitted within 30 days of the date of the letter.

In an effort to keep the procedures for Unit 1 and 2 consistent, we are developing the procedures for both units jointly. Therefore, we will be submitting the procedure for your review prior to startup following the first refueling outage (Fall 1984), consistent with St. Lucie Unit 2 License Condition 2.C.17.d.
