SUBJECT: SCHEDULE UPDATE FOR COMPLETION OF DECOMMISSIONING AT
NAVAL RESEARCH LABORATORY CHESAPEAKE BEACH DETACHMENT

The Navy's radioactive materials program is licensed with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) under Master Materials License Number 45-23645-01NA. Radiological operations involving licensed radioactive materials at Naval Research Laboratory Chesapeake Beach Detachment (NRLCBD) were authorized by Naval Radioactive Materials Permit (NRMP) No. 08-00173-E1NP. Chief of Naval Operations Washington DC letter 5090 Serial N45/14U132778 of October 10, 2014 provided the alternate decommissioning plan to the NRC for NRLCBD.

The schedule for completion of decommissioning activities at NRLCBD continues to be set for July 30, 2018. Due to a combination of funding issues and a protracted time required for data gap analysis of the original NRLCBD final status survey (FSS) report, the projected milestones from the letter of October 10, 2014 were adjusted. Enclosure (1) provides an updated schedule for completion of decommissioning activities.

Schedule Update for Completion of Decommissioning Activities Naval Research Laboratory
Chesapeake Beach Detachment (NRLCBD) – 5 July 2017

Projected Milestones

- a. July 15, 2017: Naval Sea Systems Command Detachment Radiological Affairs Support Office (NAVSEA DET RASO) obtains performance and independent government estimate to re-perform final status survey (FSS) and report for NRLCBD.
- b. July 30, 2017: Naval Sea Systems Command, Washington DC provides funding to the Army Joint Munitions Command, Rock Island, IL for completion of the FSS and report.
- c. August 15, 2017: Army Joint Munitions Command, Rock Island finalizes the contract requirements for the FSS and report, and awards the contract.
- d. November 30, 2017: Contractor completes the FSS and submits the final report to NAVSEA DET RASO for review.
- e. January 30, 2018: NAVSEA DET RASO completes the review of the FSS report and forwards it to the Naval Radiation Safety Committee (NRSC).
- f. March 30, 2018: NRSC forwards the FSS report to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission for review.
- g. July 30, 2018: NRSC removes NRLCBD area of use from NRMP No. 08-00173-E1NP.
