On July 31, 2017 I received a letter signed by John McKirgan which was dated June 30, 2017. The subject of the letter is "Review of the Draft Environmental Assessment and Finding of No Significant Impact for the Fermi 2 Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation Decommissioning Funding Plan", Docket No. 72-71, CAC No. L24950.

The letter requested a response within 30 days of receipt. The letter appears to have been in transit the entire month of July and in the interest of being as timely as possible with a reply, please accept this email as our official response. If you need a reply on DEQ letterhead as an official response, please let me know that and I will take action to get that into the mail as soon as possible.

We have completed our review of the draft and have no substantive comments. We have a single comment regarding a typographical error. Page 3 refers to the "Fermi 2 nuclear reactors" twice; however, Fermi 2 is a single reactor, so in both references, the word "reactors" should be replaced with "reactor".
