Dear Mr. Williams:

This is to acknowledge your letter to D. Eisenhut dated April 16, 1984 concerning your snubber visual inspection and the request to withdraw FP&L's pending application for a license amendment dated February 24, 1984.

As a result of conversations with members of your staff on April 11, we became aware of the fact that the last two snubbers were visually inspected and that the proposed amendment to delay that inspection was no longer needed. Based on those conversations, the staff suspended action on the amendment request at that time.

Your request to withdraw the amendment application is noted and all NRC staff activities have been terminated. However, since staff effort was expended in processing this application, the fee required pursuant to 10 CFR 170.22 which was requested by the License Fee Management Branch in a letter dated April 16, 1984 is still due and should be remitted in the amount specified in that letter.
