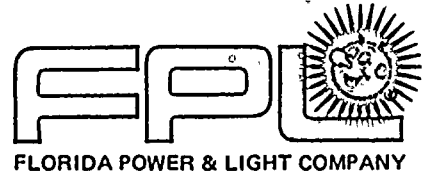

Fire Protection - Alternate Shutdown

During a meeting with members of your staff on April 25, 1984, several items regarding alternate shutdown were discussed. These items are clarified as follows:

NRC Item No. 1: Are any repairs to equipment required to achieve hot shutdown?

FPL Response: All equipment necessary to achieve hot standby is controllable from outside of the control room and cable spread room without making any repairs.

NRC Item No. 2: What is meant by "isolate" as used in the Alternate Shutdown Procedure?


FPL Response: Isolate, as used in the Alternate Shutdown Procedure, means to isolate the affected circuitry from the control/cable spread rooms and transfer total function to the indicated switch from the control/cable spread room areas to remote locations.

NRC Item No. 3: Is there annunciation in the control room for the isolate/transfer switches?

FPL Response: There are several isolate switches which do not annunciate in the control room. These switches were reviewed as part of the original plant design. For fire protection purposes, the control room will be evacuated when the isolate/transfer switches would annunciate in the control room. Therefore, annunciation in the control room of the isolate switches for fire protection is not necessary.
