

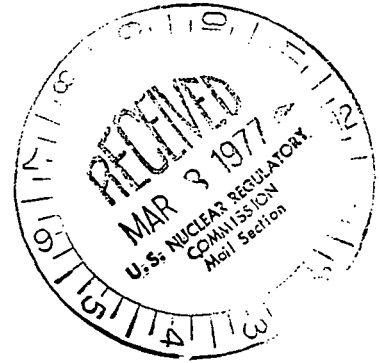

 Quad-Cities Station Units 1 and 2
 Mark I Containment Program Action Plan
NRC Docket Nos. 50-237/249 and 50-254/265

Dear Mr. Ziemann:

On October 29, 1976, General Electric transmitted Revision O of the Mark I Owners Group "Program Action Plan". In a letter to the NRC dated November 5, 1976, Commonwealth Edison requested that this document be included on the Dresden Units 2 and 3 and Quad-Cities Units 1 and 2 dockets. In a letter to Commonwealth Edison dated December 23, 1976, comments on this Program Action Plan were provided. In response to these comments, the Mark I Owners Group directed General Electric to review the Program Action Plan as appropriate to more completely describe the individual tasks in order to demonstrate that information would be generated during the program to cover the items raised. This was discussed in detail at an NRC/Mark I Owners Group meeting held in San Jose on February 2, 3, and 4. The Mark I Owners Group Program Action Plan has also been revised and was transmitted to the NRC by General Electric via L. J. Sobon's letter to V. Stello dated February 11, 1977. This revision (Revision 1) should be included on the Dresden Units 2 and 3 and Quad-Cities Units 1 and 2 dockets.

The General Electric transmittal date is later than requested in the December 23, 1976 letter to Commonwealth Edison. Due to scheduling changes for the meeting referenced in that letter, the February 11 transmittal date was mutually agreed to by the NRC and the Mark I Owners Group. With the Program Action Plan update completed, it is anticipated that the staff's Safety Evaluation Report on the Mark I Short Term Program will be issued in the near future.
