

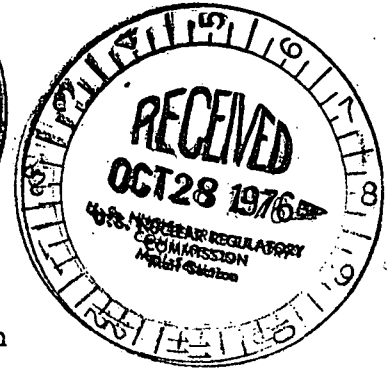
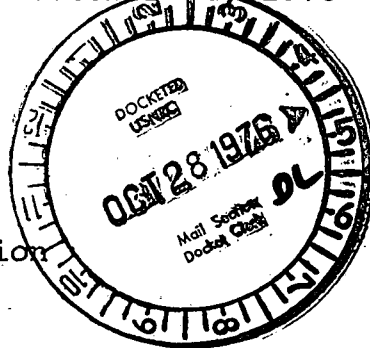

Dear Mr. Ziemann:

Reference (a) reported the failure of the Unit 3 diesel generator cooling water pump and the temporary replacement of the submersible model with that originally installed. Replacement was estimated to be completed by August 30, 1976.

The replacement pump arrived in early September, but the decision was made to replace the Unit 2 diesel generator cooling water pump at that time. The Unit 2 pump was exhibiting signs of wear and the Unit 3 shutdown for refueling outage was imminent. Delivery of the Unit 3 pump is now scheduled for October 29, 1976 with installation expected prior to the completion of the refueling outage.

You will be advised of any further changes in this schedule.
