NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF FACILITY LICENSE AMENDMENTS

Notice is hereby given that the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission (the Commission) has issued Amendment Nos. 3 and 8 to Facility Operating License Nos. DPR-25 and DPR-29 (respectively) to the Commonwealth Edison Company (and in the matter of License No. DPR-29, the Iowa-Illinois Gas and Electric Company) which revised Technical Specifications for operation of the Dresden Unit 3 (located in Grundy County, Illinois) and Quad-Cities Unit 1 (located in Rock Island County, Illinois).

The amendments permit replacement of one reactor coolant system electromatic relief valve with a combination safety/relief valve and other related changes.


The application for the amendments complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations, and the Commission has made appropriate findings as required by the Act and the Commission's rules and regulations in 10 CFR Chapter I which are set forth in the license amendments.
