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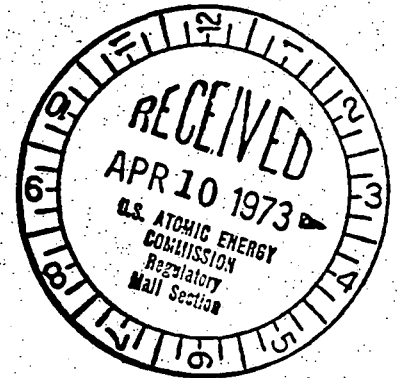

This letter is to certify to the Atomic Energy Commission that with respect to discharges from Commonwealth Edison Company's Dresden Generating Station Unit 3 at Morris, Illinois, there is not at the present time an applicable effluent limitation or other limitation under Section 301 or 302 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972, and there is not at the present time an applicable standard under Section 306 or 307 of the Act.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 401(d) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972, the State of Illinois hereby incorporates all applicable provisions of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (Chapter 111 1/2, Illinois Revised Statutes, §1001 et seq.), and of Chapter 3: Water Pollution, of the Rules and Regulations of the Illinois Pollution Control Board effective pursuant thereto, and of the Order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board dated March 29, 1973, in the matter of the Petition for Variance of Commonwealth Edison Company, PCB-72-350, as conditions of the AEC license for this facility. The Agency will shortly provide copies of the relevant legislation, regulations, Order, and a statement of the specific provisions thereof which are to be incorporated in the Dresden Generating Station Unit 3 AEC license.

Subject to the provisions of Section 401 of the Act, this certification may be subject to amendment, modification, or revocation by the Agency as a result of public hearings or other proceedings which may take place pursuant to the provisions of the Act or of State law.
