## ANSWER OF COMMONWEALTH EDISON COMPANY TO PETITION TO INTERVENE OF HARRIET SHERMAN

Commonwealth Edison Company, by its attorneys, Isham, Lincoln & Beale, in answer to the petition to Intervene of Harriet Sherman represent as follows:

1. Petitioner has failed to set forth the interest which is relevant to this proceeding or which is within the jurisdiction of the Commission and has failed to show that her interests are affected by any matter which is relevant to the issues in this proceeding or within the jurisdiction of this Commission.

2. To the extent that it is possible to comprehend the matter alleged in the Petition, it would appear that the interests of the Petitioner are to investigate the investments of the Catholic Archbishop of Chicago and perhaps of the Vatican State, the alleged use of electric power as a weapon over the people, all aspects of this Commission's operations, and fancied conflicts of interest of various individuals and organizations. 3. Said interests are not relevant to the issues of this proceeding and are not within the jurisdiction of the Commission. To hold a hearing to consider the irrelevant contentions of Petitioner would result in delays in making Dresden Unit 3 available to supply the needs of the public for electric power and thereby be detrimental to Petitioner and the public.

WHEREFORE, Commonwealth Edison Company respectfully urges that the Commission deny the Petition to Intervene of Harriet Sherman.
