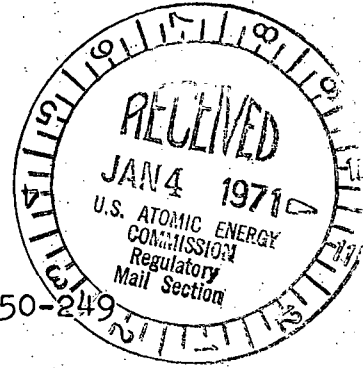

MOTION OF APPLICANT COMMONWEALTH EDISON COMPANY  
TO LOAD FUEL AND TO CONDUCT CERTAIN TESTS

Commonwealth Edison Company ("Commonwealth") by its attorneys, Isham, Lincoln & Beale, respectfully moves that:

1. The United States Atomic Energy Commission enter an order or issue a license, permit or other authorization as may be deemed appropriate authorizing Commonwealth to commence and complete the initial fuel loading and conduct certain tests at atmospheric pressure and at zero or near zero power with the reactor pressure vessel open including only those tests specified in Section 13.8.3 of the Dresden 2 and 3 Safety Analysis Report.

2. The activities for which authorization is requested herein are within the scope of the Notice of Proposed Issuance of Facility Operating License, dated November 18, 1970, issued in this proceeding and further that the petitioners, David Dinsmore Comey and B.P.I. Action Fund, Inc., who have filed their petition to intervene in the above captioned proceeding have no opposition to the foregoing motion and do not request a hearing in respect thereof all as more fully set forth in the attached stipulation.

STIPULATION

Applicant, Commonwealth Edison Company and David Dinsmore Comey, on behalf of himself and B.P.I. Action Fund, Inc., Intervening Petitioners, stipulate as follows:

1. Intervening Petitioners do not oppose the foregoing motion to conduct fuel loading and open vessel tests of Commonwealth Edison Company nor the entry of any order, license, permit or other authorization as deemed appropriate to permit Commonwealth Edison Company to engage in the activities set forth in said motion and further Intervening Petitioners do not request that a hearing be held in respect of the entry of any such order, license, permit or other authorization.

2. The foregoing stipulation shall not constitute or be construed as constituting a waiver of any right to a hearing on any other operation of Dresden Unit 3, including low power testing with the reactor vessel head in place, nor

a waiver of any issues or allegations raised in the Petition to Intervene and Commonwealth Edison Company shall not argue that such stipulation constitutes such a waiver.
