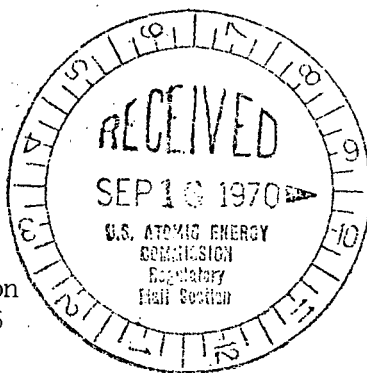

We have reviewed the Environmental Statement prepared by the Commonwealth Edison Company for the Dresden Nuclear Power Station Unit 3 as requested by your letter of August 6, 1970.

The following comments on the Environmental Statement are provided:

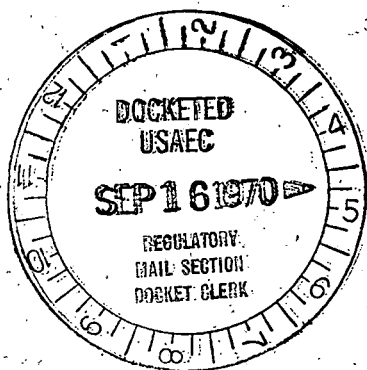
1. Detailed information regarding the environmental monitoring program is not contained within the Statement. The specification of sample types as well as their frequency and location should be included in the Environmental Statement.

2. The word "minute" should be inserted between "1.75" and "holdup" on line 6 of page 7.

3. Based on the analysis of the Environmental Statement, it is concluded that if conditions are met for approval by the AEC of the pending application for the necessary permits and licenses to construct and operate the proposed Dresden Nuclear Power Station Unit 3, there is reasonable assurance that the environment will not be adversely affected.
